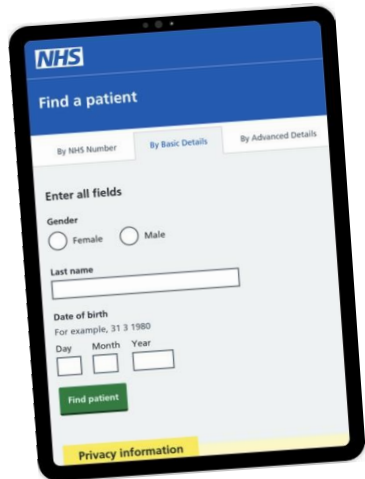
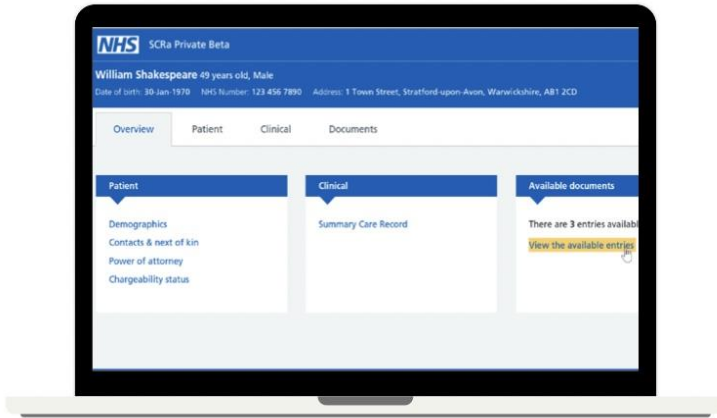

Our Products - SCRa and NRL



Summary Care Record application (SCRa) private beta uses Biometric Authentication to access:

- Summary Care Record
- Demographics & Edit Capability
- Child Protection Information
- Reasonable Adjustments flag
- Covid status & Shielded Patient flag



National Record Locator (NRL) is a national index of pointers to patient records such as:

- Advanced/Emergency care plans
- eRedBag
- Mental health care plan
- End of life care plans

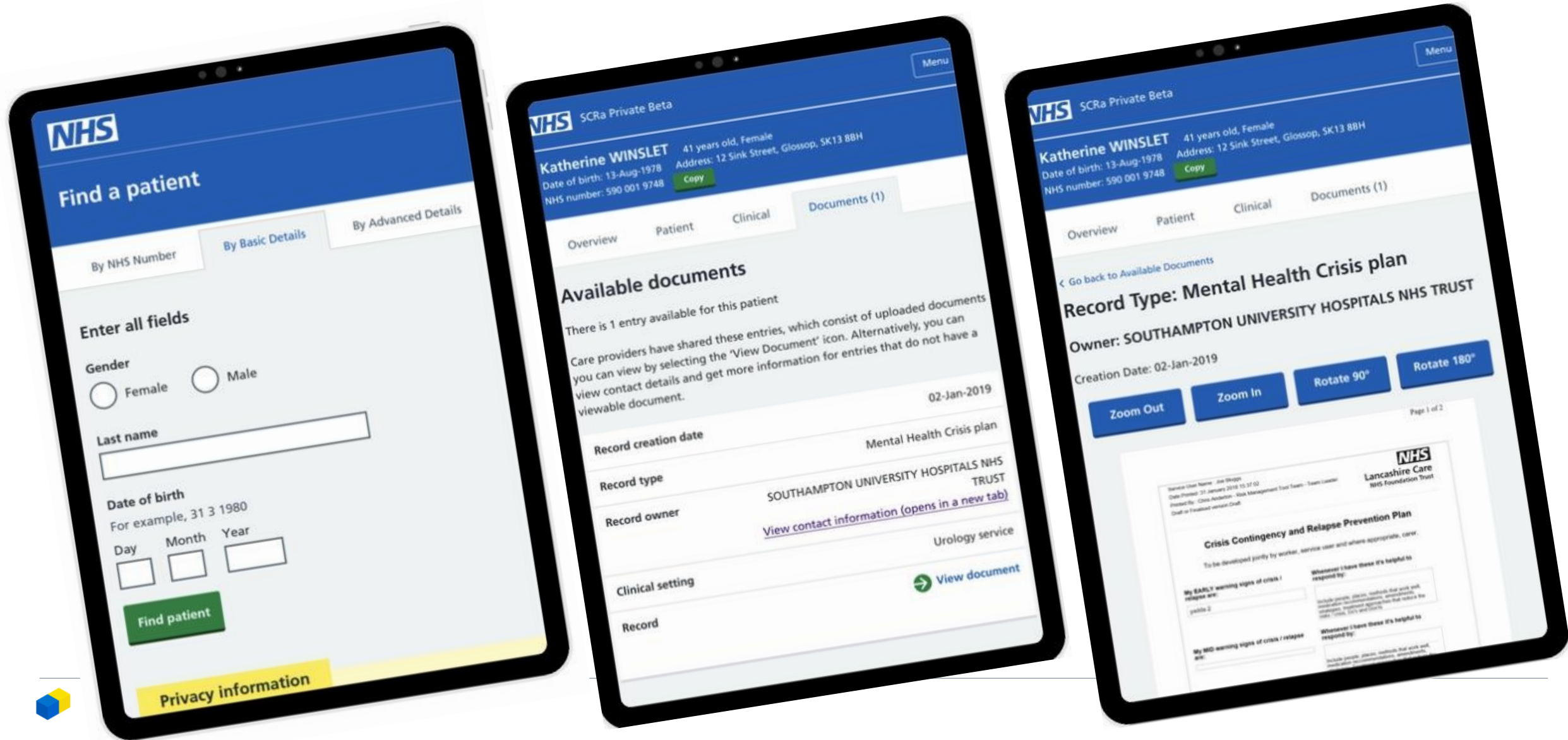


Purpose of the National Record Locator

To enable clinicians to legitimately access records for patients, at the point of delivery, no matter where the patient lives or which supplier provides the records

- Frequent Caller Team
- Integration with the HIE Viewer – which will mean our clinicians can view NRL records from one application
- Creation of a Mental Health Pathway – any mental health care plans will flag and redirect the call to a mental health specialist

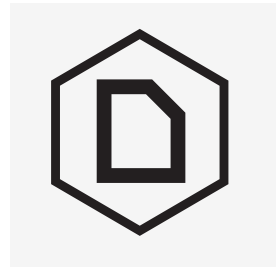
